"I've been fortunate enough to have fished the Golfo Dulce many times over the last ten seasons and I've come to expect the extraordinary, but this recent trip was the best yet. It started with a Dorado blitz that produced nonstop action with big bull dolphin and a very respectable sailfish. One guest that was fishing solo cried "uncle" and couldn't handle another mahi mahi. Gregg managed to sneak out of the lodge for a busman's holiday (funny how he always manages to pick the right days) and he scored the monster Dorado you see pictured above.

I jumped in the water twelve miles off the coast (a short run from the lodge) next to some floating debris to get a fish-eye perspective of what was going on under the surface...it was an awesome spectacle! Over the next hour I chronicled life and death in the open ocean photographing brown boobies bobbing for baby triple tails, thousands of spawning bonito, hundreds of dorados parading by in waves, jacks, google-eyes, rainbow runners, jacks, trigger fish and a frisky turtle that wanted me to be his buddy.

While I was filming the action below, Gregg, Ron Thibaudeau and Captain Javier were dueling with dorado, including some monsters.

It's hard to put into word just how zany the action was...so hopefully the following photo essay and video snippet will give you a feeling for what The Zancudo Lodge regularly serves up for anglers that are looking for that fishing trip of a lifetime."

This area of Costa Rica boasts the greatest biodiversity on the planet and the underwater realm is home to an amazing array of fish, marine mammals and even reptiles.

Eye-Candy was everywhere I looked: the mangroves, river, gulf, offshore and even in front of my room.

There are so many different ecosystems nearby; you can kayak or boat up river where you can photograph crocodiles and egrets.

You can journey up the bay where you'll find a wonderful wildlife refuge and botanical garden. Venture offshore and watch acres of spinner dolphins corkscrewing out of the waves. Turtles seem to pop up everywhere and rare and beautiful, yellow sea snakes slither across the surface.

A dazzling array of birds visit the 7 acres of lush tropical flowers and fruit trees that decorate the lodge property.

LIFELONG DREAM COMES TRUE

Ron Thibaudeau had fished his whole life with the dream of someday catching a marlin. He had fished the waters off the Golfo Dulce on five previous trips to other resorts, but Ron wasn't able to put the marlin notch on his belt...that changed with his December visit to The Zancudo Lodge.

Ron had already experienced some fantastic fishing with a daylong duel with monster dorado, a nice sailfish brought boat side, a fair size yellowfin that came unbuttoned next to the boat and a respectable roosterfish. Cap that off with fantastic weather and it already had been a fabulous fishing trip.

Then the marlin above rocked Ron's world with a fight that started off with the fish thrashing the water into a fountain-like display that would rival the Bellagio in Vegas, then 25 jumps in quick succession melting line off the reel. It was an epic standup battle that lasted 45 grueling minutes before the fish was tagged and released. I had a few minutes to snap a few fish-eye portraits.

"MEN STAND UP, WOMEN SIT DOWN"

When it comes to technique for fighting marlin, Gregg states emphatically, "Men stand up, women sit down."

A marlin estimated at 450 pounds crashed the lures, not once but twice, and managed to avoid the hook. Javier slowly worked his way back to the same area thirty minutes later and was reworded with a solid hook up.

Gregg put the pressure on the 200 plus pound marlin and had it boat side within 20 short minutes.

As was the case with Ron's marlin, Captain Sloan Gurney, acting as mate for the day, shouted out encouragement and helpful suggestions before he billed the fish.





FLYING FISH







Think like a fish

In order to find, fool, hook & land a billfish, you have to be able to think like a billfish. The captains at the lodge are all masters at reading the water and finding fish. Each boat is equipped with state of the art electronics and the captains and mates know how to use these tools to your advantage -- catching trophy size fish.

Almost every fish we caught went airborne.

Dorado, Mahi Mahi, or Dolphin are one of the fastest growing fish in the sea; they can grow and inch a week and reach 30 pounds in a year. They mature at about 6 months of age and females are believed to reach maturity at a smaller size than males. Dorado are highly fecund producing 58,000 - 1.5 million eggs per female, with an exponential increase. They can also spawn frequently when mature, yet most are short lived with a maximum age of four years with most dying before 2 years.

When examined, the 1976 IGFA world record mahi mahi of 87 pounds was found to be only four years old.

Our crew of two anglers landed 16 dorado, all of them over 25 pounds.

George, a frequent visitor to the lodge, took the two beautiful fish in the picture to the left.

The yellowfin tuna was served up only minutes later as sashimi and sushi rolls. Later that night we also sampled the lodge's famous dorado with mango sauce and it was delicious.
